

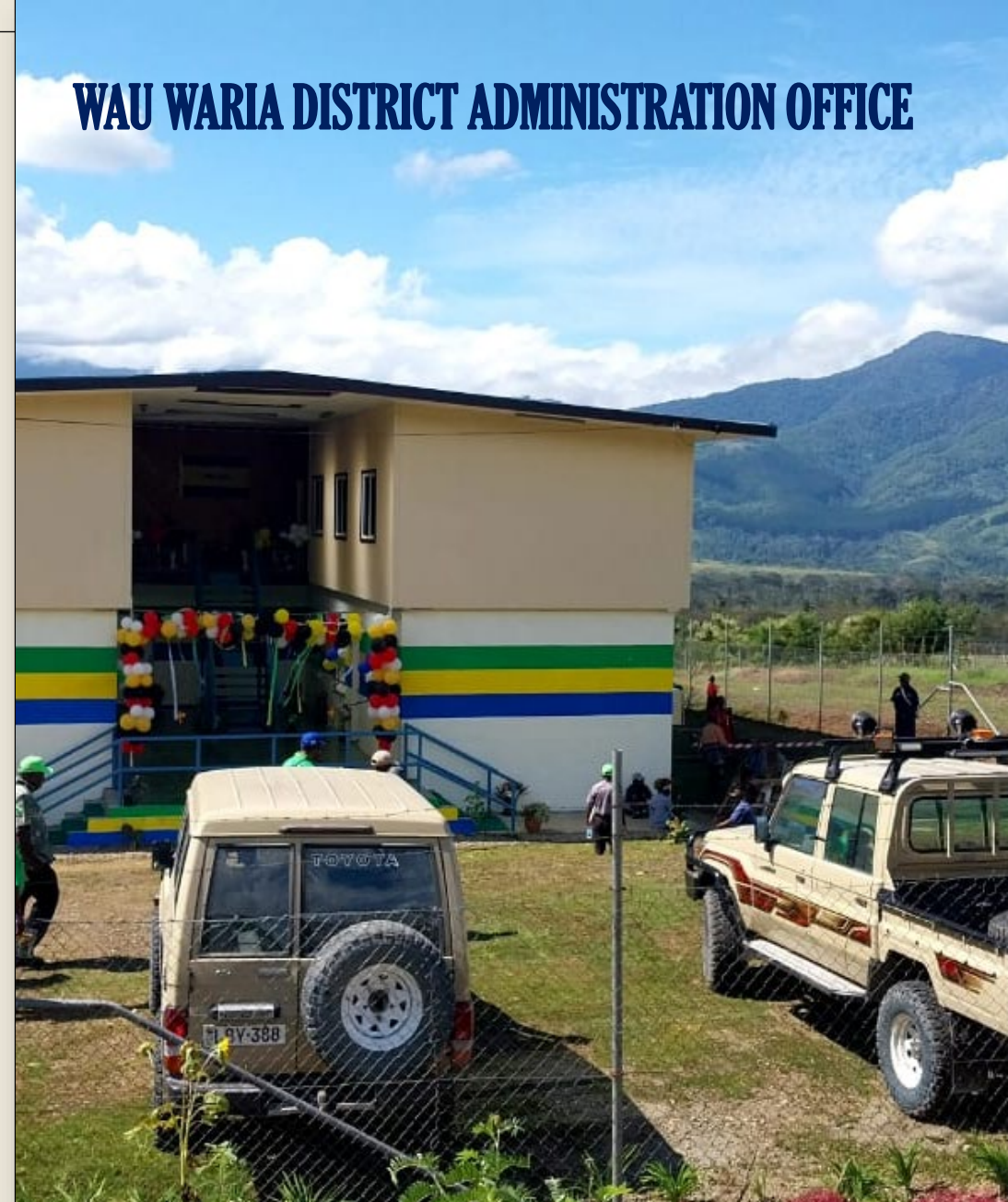

❖ Key Highlights

Year 2022

- Conducted 2022 National Election and declaration of the pioneer National Member of Parliament Hon Masrh Narewec.
- Establishment of Wau Waria District Head Quarters in Wau Town
- Establishment of Wau Waria District Development Authority (WWDDA)
- Completion of Wau Bulolo office complex which was converted into District office.
- Put in place staff to execute roles and responsibilities of the DDA
- Establishment of District Finance office

Year 2023

- Successful completion and commissioning of the District base line survey
- Hosting of District Development Forum
- Formulation and launching of Wau Waria District Development Plan 2023 – 2027 by Right Prime Minister of PNG Hon James Marape
- Commissioning and the Conduct of full road feasibility study on the Morobe Northern High Way
- Signing of several MOUs with various development partners for collaborative development assistance for sustainable development in Wau Waria District
- Establishment of District Procurement Committee (DPC).
- Connection to Data Co LTD Fiber Optic Broad Band network with Access to 9 sites including Education institutions , Police station District and Finance offices
- Purchase of three (3) vehicles for the District



Year 2024

- Purchase and launching of District heavy equipment for District Works Unit
- Commencement of construction on the Morobe Northern Highway from Sumu to Garaina
- Conduct major feasibility study on the Wau town water supply by ADRA PNG.
- Secured K900,000.00 from Rural Airstrip Agency for upgrade of three (3) rural airstrips in the District
- Secured various PIP funding for road infrastructure and other development funding
- Preparatory work on the new Wau Rural Hospital
- Construction of two (2) new feeder roads
- Maintenance of Wau to Waria Northern Highway
- Major rehabilitation of Wau Kaindi road
- Installation of Integrated Financial Management system (IFMS) at the District Finance office.



Major Challenges

Wau being the first ever colonial town in PNG and also now the new District Head Quarters for the Wau Waria District. We have been facing a lot of challenges in the implementation of our planned programs and projects. The major ones being,

- Frequent Law and order problems
- Deteriorating infrastructures that had been neglected overtime by the previous Administration and Political leadership
- Frequent power outages
- Inadequate manpower at the District Headquarters
- Lack of staff housing
- Delay in the disbursement of funds for implementation
